DR MARK Lynne was invited to talk at the Dover Ladies Luncheon Club in Dover Town Hall on March 30, playing a melodeon, a small organ popular in the 19th century, similar to the harmonium and concertina.

Dr Lynne took members through the seasons, telling them stories and singing songs bringing to life the folklore of Kent.

Members were happy to try the instruments, a concertina is a free-reed musical instrument, like the various accordions and the harmonica.

It has a bellows, and buttons typically on both ends of it.

When pressed, the buttons travel in the same direction as the bellows, unlike accordion buttons, which travel perpendicularly to the bellows.
